Please be aware that a few of the scholarship funds listed here have their own, separate application and should not be applied for on the general application. Scholarship amounts vary and the larger ones may be considered multi-year scholarships and divided into equal installments during the course of study, with continued enrollment verification required. Face-to-face interviews are likely with many finalists. Renewable criteria are generally the same as original criteria, unless otherwise noted. Direct relatives of Community Foundation employees or directors are not eligible for scholarships. Please refer to the list of current employees and directors on our website. The Community Foundation reserves the right to reconsider scholarship awards if an applicant receives significant or additional scholarships. We are prohibited from making scholarship awards to any for-profit institutions.

Berkeley, Jefferson or Morgan County

Walter and Mary Jo Ziler Brown Scholarship Fund (F)(R)

Est. Scholarship: \$500

Founded by Walter and Mary Jo Brown

- A resident of Berkeley, Jefferson, or Morgan County;
- Planning a career as a veterinary technician or veterinarian or plan to study animal husbandry or agriculture;
- Based on financial need;
- May be renewable for one additional year.

Derflinger Earth Sciences Scholarship Fund (F)(R)

Est. Scholarship: \$900

Founded by Jerry Derflinger

- Graduating senior from a Berkeley, Jefferson, or Morgan County high school, U.S. Citizen;
- Planning to attend a West Virginia public college or university and pursue a degree in agriculture, forestry, geology, archeology, or environmental science;
- Based on financial need and at least a cumulative 2.0 GPA;
- May be renewable for up to 4 years (2.0 GPA).

Destiny Baptist Church Patrick J. Walker Scholarship Fund (F)(R)

- May be renewable up to four years (GPA requirements 2.5 after Freshman year, 2.75 after Sophomore year and 2.9 after Junior year).

Eastern Panhandle WVU Alumni Association Scholarship Fund (F)(R)

Est. Scholarship: \$500

Founded by the Eastern Panhandle WVU Alumni Association

- Graduating senior from Berkeley, Jefferson, or Morgan County private or public high school;
- Child, step-child, or grandchild of a WVU graduate, accepted and planning to attend WVU; *include with application the name, year of graduation, and relationship of qualifying family member (WVU graduate)*
- Based on leadership and service to the community and academic consistency;
- May be renewable.

David A. "Hawk" Hawkens Scholarship Fund (F)

Est. Scholarship: \$500

Founded by Michael and Susan Hawkens Whalton

- Graduating senior of a Berkeley, Jefferson, or Morgan County high school or home-school program within the last 18 months;
- Planning to attend a two-or four-year college or university;
- Based on financial need, as well as, academic preparation, leadership, and service to the community.

Martin Luther King Scholarship Fund (F)

Est. Scholarship: \$1,000

Founded by the Martin Luther King Scholarship Committee

- Graduating senior from a Berkeley, Jefferson, or Morgan County high school;
- Based on financial need, academic preparation, leadership, service to the community, and at least a cumulative 2.5 GPA;
- Will not be awarded to those receiving a full scholarship, such as the McCormick Scholarship.

J. Oakley Seibert Memorial Scholarship Fund (P)(R)

Est. Scholarship: \$1,500

Founded by the friends and family of the late J. Oakley Seibert

- A resident of Berkeley, Jefferson or Morgan County;
- **This scholarship has a separate application** and is intended for students planning to attend an accredited law school within 18 months after completing a four-year degree;
- Based on financial need, academic preparation, and service to the community;
- Preference given to recipients who express a good faith intent to return to Berkeley County to practice law within three years of graduation (please address in your “Top 10 List”);
- May be renewable (priority given to first year law student).

Clyde E. Smith Jr. Scholarship Fund (F)

Est. Scholarship: \$800

Founded by Stewart and Candace Berger and Clyde E. Smith III

- Graduating senior from a Berkeley, Jefferson, or Morgan County high school;
- Plan to pursue a degree in business;
- Based on financial need and scholastically average grades;
- Priority given to those unlikely to receive other scholarships such as the West Virginia PROMISE.

The Inspiration Scholarship Fund (F)(R)

Est. Scholarship: \$2,000

Founded by Kristi Hedges in memory of Thelma Henry and Viola Hedges

- Graduating senior from a Berkeley, Jefferson or Morgan County high school;
- Have a GPA of 3.5 or higher and in the top 10% of the graduating class;
- Be the first generation in their immediate family who plans to attend an accredited college or university offering a degree program of not less than two years;
- Have acceptance and will attend a college or university *outside* the state of West Virginia;
- Priority shall be given to students unlikely to benefit from other scholarships or financial grants;
- May be renewable for up to 4 years (with continued enrollment at a college or university *outside* of West Virginia and at least a 2.75 GPA after freshman year, 2.9 GPA after sophomore year and 3.2 GPA after Junior year).

West Virginia Wing-Civil Air Patrol Cadet Scholarship Fund (F)(R)

Est. Scholarship: \$2,000

Founded by Dennis D. Barron

- Cadets from ANY of the squadrons of the West Virginia Wing – Civil Air Patrol, who are graduating seniors from a public or private high school or homeschool;
- Have a GPA of 2.5 or higher and have the endorsement/recommendation of his/her unit commander along with the leadership skills proven by earning CAP Amelia Earhart award or higher;
- Plan to attend an accredited technical school, college, or university within the USA offering a certificate or degree program of not less than 1 year;
- Have acceptance from and will attend the technical school, college or university of his/her choice and to continue to receive the scholarship recipient shall maintain a 2.5 after year one and 2.75 thereafter.

- Priority given to those unlikely to receive other scholarships such as the West Virginia PROMISE;
- May be renewable with a 3.0 average.

Dr. Gwen Steeley Memorial Scholarship Fund (F)(R)

- Graduating senior from a Berkeley or Jefferson County high school with at least a cumulative 3.0 GPA;

- Priority given to “First in the Family” and/or students seeking a degree in Business, as well as, those unlikely to receive other WV scholarships such as PROMISE.
- Every applicant consents to have their name and school name shared with Margaret Walker (or her designee), and be presented with a “nonmonetary gift”, when possible, in a public setting.

Wurzburg Family Scholarship (F)(M)
