WHAT YOUR FUNDING SUPPORTS

The Community Foundation's annual Mini Grants to Teachers program is one of several that are funded in part with contributions from our Partners in Philanthropy. Last year, 175 teachers applied for mini grants of up to \$500 each, and 88 of the grant requests were funded.

Since the program was established in 2013, we have awarded nearly \$200,000 in Mini Grants. The feedback from teachers, principals, and students has inspired us to expand the program, and with your continued support, we will be able to fund even more mini grants in 2019.

Contributions from our Partners in Philanthropy provide financial resources to increase the number of mini grants we can award, and also help underwrite the modest cost of our annual Partners in Philanthropy reception where we award the grants and honor the teachers.
