

2020 Scholarship Guidelines

The Eastern West Virginia Community Foundation (EWVCF) administers scholarship funds for Berkeley, Jefferson and Morgan county residents pursuing education in a post-secondary setting. The Community Foundation uses this application for all scholarship funds, unless otherwise specified in the **2020 Scholarship** *Criteria*.

General Information

- 1. We want you to be successful in completing this application. We are happy to answer questions or help you through the process. Please don't hesitate to call us. 304-264-0353
- 2. All information is kept confidential.
- 3. When filling this application out electronically, you have to save it to your computer before entering any data.
- 4. Applicants must have applied to one or more accredited post-secondary institutions or must be currently enrolled in a college or university at the time of application.
- 5. Please carefully read through the **2020 Scholarship Criteria** and only apply for scholarships you are eligible for.
- 6. Applicants must submit the completed application along with *all required documentation*. (See Checklist below)
- 7. All required documentation should match the information you fill out on the application. All required fields must be filled in, if it doesn't apply then please enter N/A.
- 8. Interviews may be scheduled with final candidates. We only interview for larger amount scholarships. You will receive a letter in the mail, email, and/or phone call if you have been selected for an interview.
- 9. For renewable scholarships, a renewal application (different application) *must* be submitted each year.
- 10. Incomplete applications are not considered for scholarship awards. If you have questions, please call us.
- 11. EWVCF reserves the right to reconsider scholarship awards if an applicant receives significant or additional scholarships.

Timeline & Process

- 1. EWVCF releases the scholarship application in *November/December*.
- 2. Students complete application, filling out all required fields and attaching all required documentation. *December-February*
- 3. Plan to attend one of the EWVCF Scholarship Open Houses at the EWVCF office; *Tuesday, January 7th 2:00pm-5:00pm* (snow date January 14th) or *Thursday, February 13th 2:00pm-5:00pm*.
- 4. Early bird applications must be received by *February 13* to benefit from assistance with the application process. We do this to give students a chance to change and correct their application. *No exceptions!*
- 5. Completed application packages are delivered in person to our offices or postmarked on or before *February 28th*.
- 6. All COMPLETED scholarship applications undergo a review process with volunteer committees making award selections. Interviews are conducted for certain scholarships. *March-April*
- 7. EWVCF Board of Directors makes final approval of scholarship awards. *May*
- 8. Applicants will be notified in early May, *only if selected* to receive a scholarship award. (Notification will come by way of an invitation to our 2020 Scholarship Awards Reception)
- 9. If awarded, students will be given a scholarship acceptance form that must be completed and returned to the EWVCF office by *June 17th*.
- 10. Scholarship awards will be mailed to the colleges in *July*. (Scholarships are paid directly to a student's educational institution on his or her behalf. Scholarships to for-profit institutions are prohibited)

Application Package Checklist (Incomplete application packages will not be considered!)

- □ Completed and signed application form. Any required fields left blank will make your application incomplete.
- □ No more than three letters of recommendation (at least one must be academic).
- ☐ Most recent school transcript (copies accepted).
- □ Letter(s) from college(s) acknowledging enrollment/acceptance, if possible. (for-profit institutions prohibited)
- ☐ A copy of your **ENTIRE FAFSA Student Aid Report (SAR).**
- □ Top 10 List of Things About Me (See section VI below for details).
- □ Save a copy of your completed application to your computer or make a hard copy of it for your records.
- ☐ Mail/deliver completed application package to 229 East Martin St, Suite 4, Martinsburg, WV 25401 by February 28th. (Do not bind, staple, or put the application package in folders)
